



Every year, nearly 5,000 Austrian are diagnosed with prostate cancer. In fact, prostate cancer is the most common type of tumor affecting men in the industrialized countries. Thus, when it comes to men's health, prostate cancer is what comes first to our mind.

Offering all the available treatment options - from surgical removal of the entire prostate, to the increasingly more common active surveillance (depending on how aggressive the tumor is) - a representative number of first-class urologists work at the Wiener Privatklinik, treating not only prostate cancer, but also prostate enlargement, erectile dysfunction, or testosterone deficiency.



Center for Sports Medicine and Trauma Surgery

Since it is estimated that one in five accidents in Austria is a sport related accident, the Center for Sports Medicine and Trauma Surgery at Wiener Privatklinik offers specialized therapy and rehabilitation for accidental injuries of all kinds and severities.



Targeting both recreational and professional athletes, treatment is provided for a large area of situations from contusions and fractures, to complex injuries to tendons, ligaments and muscles. In doing so, we focus on minimally invasive surgery.

While trauma surgery concerns the recovery after an accident or permanent damage to the musculoskeletal system, sports medicine's main function is prevention. Thus, the associated health risks related to the excessive demands on recreational and competitive athletes could be avoided through periodic medical examinations and training support.

It's a fact that cardiovascular diseases are already responsible for almost every other death in the modern industrial societies. While some of the factors leading to this situation could be reduced or eliminated (e.g. smoking, unhealthy diet, lack of physical activity), the ageing process will unavoidably cause the remodeling of the cardiovascular system which usually leads to degenerative changes. One or two hundred years ago, people simply did not grow old enough to develop cardiovascular diseases, but nowadays and in the years to come we witness a steady increase in life expectancy.



Specialized in the diagnosis and therapy of cardiac and vascular diseases, Wiener Privat-Klinik's Center for Cardiovascular Medicine offers state-of-the-art methods and technology, as well as a fully equipped catheter laboratory. Since cardiovascular medicine not only deals with congenital and acquired heart diseases, but also with circulation and blood vessels in the heart's vicinity, we treat a large spectrum of cardiovascular affections, including but not limiting to high blood pressure (hypertension), strokes, arterial occlusive disease, and related affections.

Millesi Center at Wiener Privatklinik offers an innovative integrated treatment concept concerning nerve injuries, pain syndromes and nerve reconstructions, including nerve transplantation. An interdisciplinary team of specialists attends patients for diagnosis, surgery and neuro-rehabilitation, while constant research in this medical field allows us to offer treatment methods corresponding to the newest international standards in science.



Previous years have shown that best results in therapy are obtained by considering the brain, the central nervous system, the peripheral nerves and the muscular system as one functional unit. While in the past it was evaluated as a success when an injured person could flex the entire paralyzed elbow again, today, even in the most difficult cases, it is aimed for complex, target-oriented motions which can only be achieved by including the paralyzed part of the muscular system and the brain in the therapy.

In recent years, therapy has rapidly evolved from open surgery to minimally invasive surgical procedures: microtherapy. Microtherapy involves only a small pinprick under local anesthesia and the use of instruments like needles, catheters and tubes guided by X-rays, computer tomography and ultrasound precisely to specific parts of the body, in order to avoid injuring vital anatomical structures like nerves, vessels or organs.

The advantages of this treatment are various and range from the avoidance of a general anesthesia, minimal risk of infection and complication, no actual scarring and reduced post-operative pain, to a generally shorter hospital stay and a more rapid recovery.



Center for Microtherapy at the Wiener Privatlinik offers image-guided and minimally invasive therapy options for treating diseases of various organs or body parts, patients being attended by the best specialists in the fields of general medicine, surgery, dermatology, vascular surgery, gynecology, internal medicine, neurosurgery, neurology, plastic surgery, physical medicine, orthopedics and trauma surgery.




