- The World's Best Hospitals 2025 ranking is based on insights from over 85,000 medical experts, patient satisfaction, and highest quality standards.

<u>Wiener Privatklinik</u>, one of Austria's largest private hospitals, has been recognized for the fifth consecutive year in the annual *World's Best Hospitals* ranking, published by *Newsweek* and *Statista*. The 2025 edition features 2,445 hospitals from 30 countries, making it the most extensive and international ranking to date.

The ranking is based on a comprehensive study encompassing three main pillars: **hospital recommendations** from over 85,000 doctors, clinic managers, and medical professionals, gathered through an international survey, **patient satisfaction data**, assessing their experience and quality of care received, as well as **hospitals' quality metrics**, reflecting their overall medical standards.

The most in demand medical services were oncological treatments, complex surgical procedures, second-opinion consultations, and personalized check-up packages.

Wiener Privatklinik operates two <u>representative offices</u> in Romania, located in Bucharest and Timișoara. Additionally, patients can access online consultations via the <u>WPK Online Healthcare Center</u>, which connects them to experts in over 20 medical specialties.
